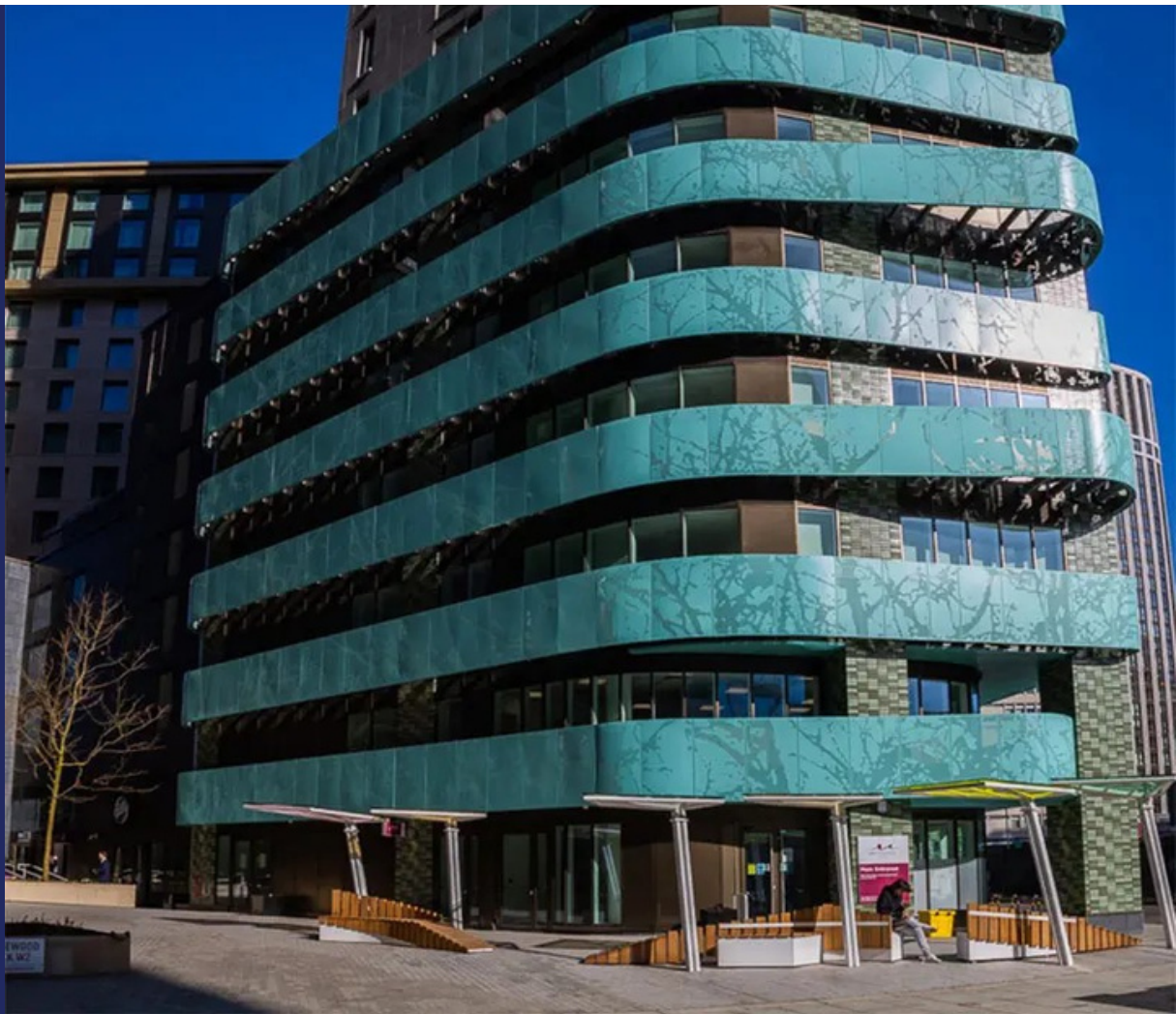
Our mission is to ensure every student, regardless of background, is well-educated and achieves the highest possible academic outcomes for a successful and fulfilled life.

We are a relatively small sixth form, which means we can get to know you personally, and can therefore offer tailored support and advice, both with university applications or apprenticeships, should those be the routes you choose to go down.

Our sixth form site is exclusively for Year 12 and 13, allowing our students to have their own dedicated space. The students also have a range of fantastic facilities available to them at our main school site, such as specialist rooms for Design & Technology, Art, Music and Science.

Situated at the centre of one of London's most dynamic business districts, we offer students unique opportunities to connect with global employers. These experiences help students develop confidence, ambition and the professional skills needed to succeed in higher education, employment and the modern world.



Marylebone Academy celebrated its sixth set of A Level results this year. Across the board, 26% of students achieved A* to A, 45% of students achieved grades A* to B and 68% achieved grades A* to C.

This year's results highlight a strong interest in students studying social sciences and business, with achievement across departments, including:

- Further Maths 100% A*-B
- Classics 100% A*-B
- Economics 94% A*-B
- Business 60% A*-B
- Maths 58% A*-B

Almost half of all A Level entries achieved A* - B grades in 2026.

Through our unique location in central London, students gain valuable insight into the world of work. All Year 12 students undertake a one-week work experience placement and receive a dedicated 1:1 careers guidance interview to support their next steps. We have a programme of 'Development Days' to equip students with practical life skills, increased independence and the confidence to navigate the opportunities and challenges of adult life.

A vibrant central London setting

Our Sixth Form is located in the heart of Paddington Basin, offering students the unique opportunity to study in one of London's most dynamic and well-connected areas. There are a range of spaces that students can access to support their studies and personal wellbeing throughout the day.

- The **Common area** located on the ground floor of the Sixth Form building is a social space where students can meet friends and relax during breaks. This area helps foster the strong sense of community that is central to our Sixth Form life.
- The **Silent Study** space is a dedicated area for independent study, designed to provide a calm and focused environment free from distractions. This space is supervised by a member of staff and supports students in making the most of their study periods
- The **Canteen** at the main school building offers a range of food and refreshments at break times.
- The **Gym** is located in the sixth form sports hall and students are free to use outside of lesson times and dedicated study periods.

Our central London location gives students access to a variety of cafés and public spaces nearby, providing additional opportunities for independent study, group work and socialising beyond the school environment.

How to apply

Entry requirements

We have capacity for 240 students in the Sixth Form. This includes capacity for 120 students in Year 12.

Candidates must secure at least 5 Grade 6 GCSEs, including at least a Grade 5 in Maths and English Language or Literature. Please also check the subject specific entry requirements for the subjects you are considering to study.
